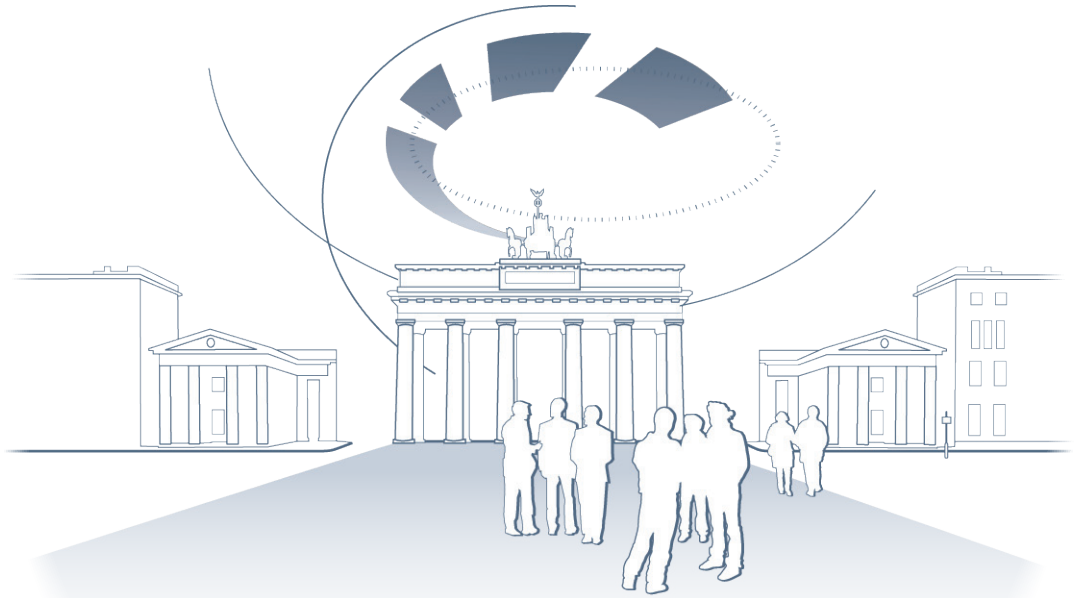

## Efficiency and ELM 4 – The path to frugal use of time and resources

Until recently, Microsoft Exchange Servers ran as a secondary system, while e-mail communications simultaneously became a bottomless pit that swallowed up incalculable amounts of time and money and became a serious legal liability.

As the use of e-mail intensifies, mailboxes overflow and employees find it impossible to either send or receive new messages. Soon they begin deleting e-mails in order to make room for new messages. This is a dangerous pattern! Such cleanup efforts often result in the loss of important information. Once the information is lost, it is lost forever and may cause significant financial damage.

This also causes unnecessary strain on the IT budget. As the volume of data grows, hardware must be continuously upgraded with costly storage media.

## Document Management: The keystone of modern banking

In September of 2008, Allianz and Commerzbank agreed that Commerzbank would take over Dresdner Bank AG.

According to the terms, clients mediated by Allianz would be transferred to a branch of Oldenburgische Landesbank AG, i.e. Allianz Bank, within half a year.

In this context, a new DMS had to be provided for migration purposes and in support of paperless processes.
